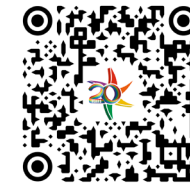

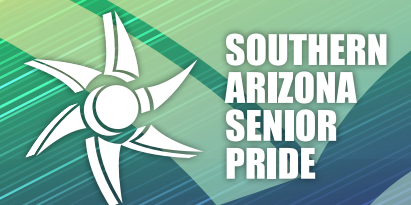

## PROGRAMS

**Empowered by You: Achieving Even More!** Senior Pride's volunteer support increased by **over 28%**. Trained volunteers provided **7,546 hours** of support **valued at \$239,962** (Independent Sector). Volunteers lent their expertise to the board of directors, facilitating activities & events, and support programs to better serve the older LGBTQI+ community.

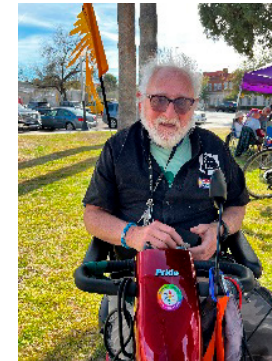

### COMMUNITY CARES PROGRAM (CCP)

Trained volunteers increased the support provided to older LGBTQI+ community members by **42%**. Many who experience isolation & loneliness and may be homebound and/or living with a disability.

- 24 volunteers
- 800 individual visits
- 21 recipients
- 1,345 volunteer hours

Average Monthly Program Participation **SURGED** by **over 32%**, now benefiting **221** individuals. Senior Pride organized over 265 Activities & Events, resulting in **2,648** interactions with LGBTQI+ older adults in 2023.



### GRIEF & LOSS SUPPORT GROUPS

Offering 3 groups weekly to provide a safe and supportive space for participants to share their experiences of grief & loss, and transitions.



### ADVANCE MEDICAL CARE PLANNING

Serving over 209 individuals at Honoring a Life workshops, community resource fairs, and individual coaching sessions.



### ARTS & CULTURE

Because arts, culture and history are important to us, we offer a variety of opportunities to celebrate our LGBTQI+ community. We also promote events and programs offered by other welcoming organizations.



### HEALTH & WELLBEING

Health and wellbeing programs for LGBTQI+ older adults promote inclusivity, address specific health challenges, foster community support, enhance mental health, and improve overall quality of life and longevity.



### SOCIAL & LEARNING

Social and learning programs for older LGBTQI+ adults increase connectivity, reduce isolation, and provide opportunities to learn new skills, fostering personal growth and community belonging.
